14 TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS LAW REGARDING THE  
15 USE OF HELMETS BY MOTORCYCLE PASSENGERS

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-20-104(b), concerning the equipment used  
22 by motorcycle passengers and operators, is amended to read as follows:

23 (b) All passengers and operators of motorcycles and motor-driven  
24 cycles used upon the public streets and highways of this state shall be  
25 equipped with the following equipment under standards set forth by the Office  
26 of Motor Vehicle of the State of Arkansas:

27 (1) Protective headgear ~~unless the person is twenty-one (21)~~  
28 ~~years of age or older~~; and

29 (2) Protective glasses, goggles, or transparent face shields.
